# Paul Klinger - UVA Community Credit Union Mortgages

- Discussed the importance of staying informed on housing economics.

# Mortgage Backed Securities (MBS) (29:47 - 39:44)

- Lenders sell loans back to Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac.
  - They rebundle these loans as mortgage backed securities (MBS).
  - Investors buy MBS, which consists of thousands of mortgages.
- Fannie and Freddie ensure strict guidelines for mortgages they buy.

• They play a crucial role in maintaining the real estate market.

# **Regulatory Environment**

- The CFPB (Consumer Financial Protection Bureau) has created important regulations.
  - Regulations limit overdraft fees, credit card interest rates, and annual fees.
- There is concern about potential dismantling of these regulations.
  - Billionaires and banking industry may resist regulation.

## **Portfolio Loans**

- Credit unions offer portfolio loans, keeping them in-house.
  - These loans comply with Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac standards but are not sold to them.
- Portfolio loans allow for more flexibility in lending.
  - They can address community needs, such as renovation loans for distressed properties.

# Adjustable Rate Mortgages (ARMs)

- Credit unions promote ARMs as a viable option.
  - A 7:1 ARM offers a lower rate compared to a 30-year fixed mortgage.
- The credit union's approach to ARMs is competitive.
  - Other companies may not offer ARMs due to high closing costs associated with discounted rates.

# Housing Affordability (39:44 - 46:29)

- Importance of ensuring people get into affordable houses.
